Review of Part I

Basis for surrendering all to God

- Surrendering all to God starts from understanding and allowing God’s absolute kingship over us.
- God is God, and we are not. Therefore we surrender to God.

Part II

What it takes to surrender all to God

→ Having NO “*non-negotiables*”

Non-negotiable (n):

Something that is so important that you are not willing to even negotiate about giving it up

Story of a person who had no non-negotiables (Genesis 22:1-14)

- God tested Abraham’s faith by asking him to sacrifice his son Isaac.
 - Abraham trusted in God and was willing to do what he was told to do.
 - Abraham showed his faith in God, and God stopped him from laying his hand on Isaac.

- What do you treasure and value in your life?
 - Can you give it up for the sake of God if necessary, or is it “non-negotiable”?

Story of God who gave up his Son (John 3:16)

- Abraham loved God so much that he was willing to even give up his only son.
- God loved the world so much that He *gave* his only Son, *Jesus Christ*.
→ God did not hold back His only son, but sacrificed Him to die for our sins.

Prayer:

God, please give us faith and willingness to let go of all the “non-negotiables” just as you gave your only Son, Jesus.
